On 8 November 1962 the Emperor landed with an airplane at Logiya for a visit to the Tendaho plantation. Around 1968 the irrigated area in the lower Awash plains there was 60 hectares. Near Logiya is a track, difficult to distinguish, to Hadar where the hominid "Lucy" was found. [Äthiopien 1999 p 415] In the 1970s it was a village with several dozen small buildings, mostly of crumbling masonry left over from the Italian occupation.
